Hospital cover

First Plan Plus Levels 1 & 2 hospital cover includes:

- > Access to over 2,100 consultants

Stress related cover

- > Dean Clinic Mental Health Assessment benefit of up to €100 per member in every 2 year period and up to €35 per visit (€25 under Level 1) to a maximum of 7 visits per year for Mental Health Therapy Sessions

Recuperation care

- > Convalescent care of €30 per night for up to 14 nights per claim
- > Cancer care support benefit of up to €100 for one night's accommodation for each treatment, to a maximum of €1,500 per calendar year
