Stress related cover

- > Dean Clinic Mental Health Assessment benefit of up to €100 per member in every 2 year period and up to €25 per visit to a maximum of 4 visits per year for Mental Health Therapy Sessions

Recuperation care

- > Convalescent care of €30 per night for up to 14 nights per claim
- > Cancer care support benefit of up to €100 for one night's accommodation for each treatment, to a maximum of €1,500 per calendar year
